Is this course for me?

This qualification provides a pathway to the primary trades in the construction industry with the exception of plumbing. This qualification is designed to introduce learners to the recognised trade callings in the construction industry and provide meaningful credit in a construction industry Australian Apprenticeship.

Through theory and practical course work you will learn to:

- Undertake basic measurements and calculations to determine task and material requirements
- Carry out WHS requirements through safe work practices in all on- or off-site construction workplaces
- Communicate effectively with other workers in a construction workplace environment.

Completion of this course will give you the skills and knowledge required to pursue a career in the construction industry.

Career Opportunities

Trade outcomes are predominantly achieved through an Australian Apprenticeship and this qualification allows for inclusion of skills suited for entry to off-site occupations including:

- Joinery and Carpentry
- General construction occupations

Entry Requirements

There are no entry requirements; however you must:

- Show a satisfactory level of language and literacy skills, which will be established at the time of enrolment
- Show a genuine interest in the construction industry

Support Services

Elective Units

- CPCCOM1014 Conduct workplace communication
- CPCCCA2002* Use carpentry tools and equipment
- CPCCCA2011* Handle carpentry materials
- CPCCCM2006 Apply basic levelling procedures
- CPCCCM2009* Carry out basic demolition

Tuition Fees

The current course fees are based on the Western Australian Department of Training and Workforce Development's VET Fees and Charges Policy, available to view on the website: www.dtwd.wa.gov.au

Fees and charges for all Targeted Fee Relief (Lower Fees, Local Skills) courses commenced in 2023: Non-Concession 25+: \$1.62 per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$1200 per year, Non-Concession youth 17-24: \$1.62 per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$400 per year, Concession: 48c per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$400 per year

The nominal hours for this qualification are 220, based on this the total fees are: Non-concession 25+: \$356.40, Non-concession 17-24: \$356.40, Concession: \$105.60

Fees are invoiced at the commencement of each unit. As per above, annual fee caps apply, a full breakdown of your specific fees will be provided at enrolment.
