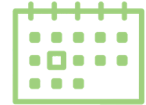

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who perform a range of servicing tasks in the automotive retail, service and repair industry.

Through theory and practical course work you will learn to:

- Carry out servicing operations
- Inspect and service braking systems
- Inspect, test and service batteries
- Inspect and service engines

This course will suit those looking to learn trade skills in automotive services, those wanting to pursue a career in the retail automotive industry and those wanting to pursue an apprenticeship in the automotive service industry.

Career Opportunities

This qualification can be undertaken as a pre-apprenticeship program and allows for inclusion of skills suited for entry as an apprentice automotive mechanic.

Entry Requirements

There are no prerequisite entry requirements; however you must:

- Show a satisfactory level of language and literacy skills, which will be established at the time of enrolment
- Show a genuine interest in the automotive industry
