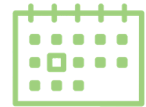

This qualification reflects the role of individuals who perform a range of tasks on tyres in the automotive retail, service and repair industry.

Through theory and practical course work you will learn to:

- Remove, inspect, repair and refit light and heavy vehicle tyres and tubes
- Remove, inspect and refit light and heavy vehicle wheel and tyre assemblies
- Balance wheels and tyres

Entry Requirements

Tuition Fees

The current course fees are based on the Western Australian Department of Training and Workforce Development's VET Fees and Charges Policy, available to view on the website: www.dtwd.wa.gov.au

Fees and charges for all Priority Industry qualification courses commenced in 2025: Non-Concession 25 +: \$3.25 per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$1200 per year, Non-Concession youth 17-24: \$3.25 per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$400 per year. Concession: 0.97c per nominal hour commenced in a calendar year, capped at \$400 per year

The nominal hours for this qualification are 288, based on this the total fees are: Non-concession 25+: \$936.00, Non-concession 17-24: \$400.00, Concession: \$279.36.

Fees are invoiced at the commencement of each unit. As per above, annual fee caps apply, a full breakdown of your specific fees will be provided at enrolment.
